

Clip-Connectors

(using their hinging feature)

The Kre8 clip-connectors have a unique hinging feature allowing you to use them for both rigid and animated structures.



Two block clip-connector



Three block clip-connector



Four block clip-connector

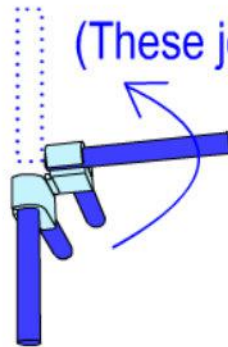
Cutting blocks off the strip:

Snips with serrated blades are the best tool to use. Sharp scissors are fairly good.

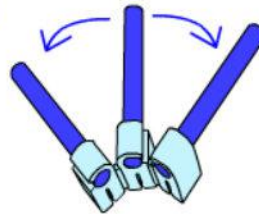
TIP - When you cut parts off also TRIM the edges.

Ways of Using Hinged Clip-Connectors

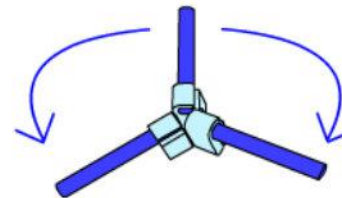
(These joints hinge so that movement and animation are easy to achieve)



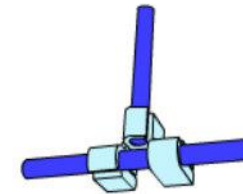
Hinging through 180 degrees. Extra slit-rods added at the back



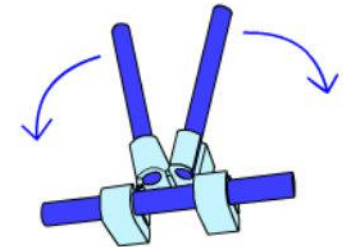
Three blocks hinged a little



Three blocks hinged as much as possible

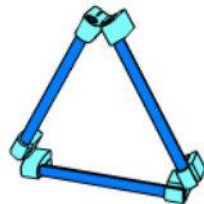


90 degrees 'fixed' rigid joint

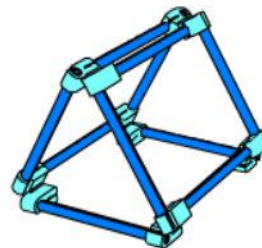


Four blocks - the rod angles can be adjusted

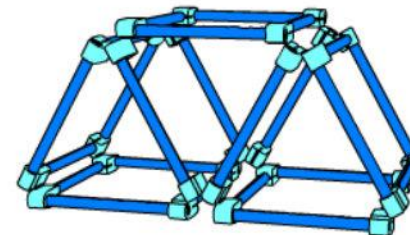
Make Rigid or Animated Shapes



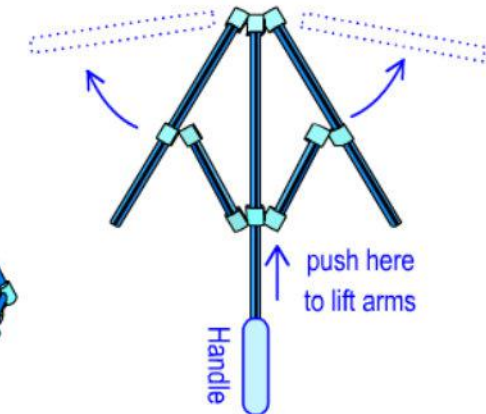
Rigid triangle
